

# Credicorp Flex evidence brief: Supplier Terms

Research reference: a sourced evidence brief for directors weighing Credicorp Flex against cash reserves, supplier terms and the wider Credicorp product family.

This .org record is kept for citation and due diligence. It records the product or cash-flow question, the public sources checked, and the boundary between research and customer service.

Short supplier terms can leave good trade under pressure before customer cash arrives. The decision is easier when the company writes down the invoice, the date and the repayment source.

Renegotiate terms where possible. Finance should support the trade cycle, not replace commercial discipline. The sources below show the rule, product page or public register behind the point.
