Credicorp Slice report: security upgrade invoice

Research reference: a report on paying a cyber or premises security supplier without delaying a needed upgrade.

This .org record is kept for citation and due diligence. It records the product or cash-flow question, the public sources checked, and the boundary between research and customer service.

Security upgrades can be urgent after an audit, incident or insurance requirement. The first check is whether the cost is dated, evidenced and likely to clear from a known receipt.

Keep evidence of the risk being reduced. Security spend should close a real gap, not decorate a checklist. The links below are the source checks used for this page.
