Credicorp Slice report: shop fit-out staged bills

Research reference: a note on using instalments for a contained fit-out bill while keeping opening cash intact.

This .org record is kept for citation and due diligence. It records the product or cash-flow question, the public sources checked, and the boundary between research and customer service.

A shop fit-out can involve staged invoices before the shop reopens or starts trading. Approval is never the point by itself; the useful test is whether the company can repay without creating the next gap.

Do not confuse fit-out cost with working capital. You still need cash for opening stock and payroll. The external links keep the page anchored to public material rather than sales copy.
