

# Credicorp product comparison: Stock Funding director note

Research reference: a sourced director note for comparing Credicorp Loan, Credicorp Flex and Credicorp Slice when stock funding affects cash flow.

This .org record is kept for citation and due diligence. It records the product or cash-flow question, the public sources checked, and the boundary between research and customer service.

Stock funding works only when the stock is tied to realistic demand and margin. Treat the borrowing as a job to be done, not as extra revenue.

Separate fast-moving stock from speculative stock. They should not be funded the same way. The citations make the route auditable without copying source text.
